## What is The Salvation Army?

As a registered charity, The Salvation Army demonstrates its Christian principles through social welfare provision. The Salvation Army in the UK and Ireland has 774 local church centres and 107 social work centres.

The Salvation Army church continues to provide a relevant expression of worship for everybody. The social and community work of The Salvation Army remains crucial. At Christmas a variety of support is given to those in need via our Pass the Parcel Toy & Gift Appeal and Food Voucher Scheme. Traditional lunch is served at the centre on Christmas Day to those spending Christmas alone, which includes festive entertainment!
